

SMU Swimming Pool Rules & Regulations

- NO LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY. USE THE POOL AT YOUR OWN RISK.
 - NEITHER SMU, NOR ITS SERVANTS OR AGENTS SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY OR DEATH OR PERSONAL INJURY (SAVE FOR DEATH OR PERSONAL INJURY RESULTING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF SMU, ITS SERVANTS OR AGENTS), HOWEVER ARISING FROM YOUR USE OF THE POOL AND OTHER FACILITIES.
 - No diving or rough play.
 - Do not use the pool if you are unwell or suffering from cuts, wounds, sores or infectious diseases.
 - No food or beverages allowed in the pool or pool area.
 - No breakable or sharp objects allowed in the pool or pool area.
 - No littering.
 - No smoking.
 - No pets allowed in the pool or pool area.
 - Only authorized persons are allowed to use the pool. Guests must be accompanied by an authorized person.
 - Children under 12 years of age or less than 1.2 metres in height must be accompanied by an adult.
 - All swimmers must wear proper swimming attire. No tee-shirts and shorts allowed.
 - Swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
